CONGREGATION VOTES FOR ADDITION AND THEN SOME

In the special congregation meeting on February 11, the members of David’s Star voted to proceed with the building program as proposed. *Then they added a big **HOWEVER** . . .*

***HOWEVER** . . .* if additional monies and pledges are made **BY EASTER SUNDAY** the entire glass enclosed narthex will be included in this building project. To date, about half of the narthex will be completed because that is as far as our current funding formula takes us. We still need an additional \$133,000 in cash and \$398,000 in pledges (commitments) to complete the narthex. Having the entire narthex available would provide a tremendous addition to our current church, substantially expanding the meeting and greeting space.

Won’t you consider making a pledge now, adding to your pledge amount, or donating additional cash to the project to make the entire narthex a reality? (Please note we need more in pledges than in actual cash.) Remember, we need to know by Easter Sunday. After that the plans will be finalized and the remainder of the narthex will not be included until sometime in the future when we build our new sanctuary.
