Volunteers- No skill needed (we can train you on certain things) or maybe you're skilled in something, you can volunteer your time to work with a crew leader (most of these have already been secured) so you won't be on your own. The items we have identified right now are where we need help:

- Clean-up and moving (during construction and final cleaning)
- Drywall work
- Painting
- Building a block retaining wall
- Concrete work
- Demolition of certain items like acoustical ceilings
- Landscaping
- Installation of cabinets
- Moving of furniture and equipment from classrooms and offices before and after the school remodel
- Communications
- Graphic Arts

Skilled tradesman- Members who work in the construction trades who can donate some of their own labor, doing what they do for a living. This work would depend on what your skill set is and what role and responsibility you would be willing to accept.

Contractors- Members that own their own company and are willing to donate either labor or materials to the project. These members may be also be interested in having their firm submit a bid for the project since they feel they can help out the congregation with some preferential pricing.
