A LOOK AHEAD

- Site demolition/excavation is ongoing. The project is continuing to use the excess fill from the excavation to level off the area north of the school, for future athletic fields.
- Concrete footings and foundation work is progressing to the west.
- The concrete block wall work has started and will be ongoing.
- The precast plank for the first phase will be set in two weeks.
- Demolition in the existing school is ongoing.
- The HVAC contractor is working on the demolition of the old boiler system in the school.
- The Electrical contractor is working on the demolition of the old electrical service in the school.
- The work associated with the new septic system started last week and will be ongoing.
- We have established the construction boundaries and have closed the West side and the South side entrances to the school (the one further West on the South side). The only entrance to the school is through the back door near the current Kindergarten room.
- The turn-around drive and associated parking West of the school will be off limits.
- Access to the Parish Center is limited to parking in our church parking lot and walking through the cemetery to the parish center.
- The parking lot South of the school, by the church office, will be limited starting Monday June 1st. Access to the church office will be maintained.
- Construction activity will be Monday thru Friday 6:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.
- Construction signage is posted at all building entrances affected by construction.

Loan Process Update

The bank is in the process of getting the property appraisal completed. The appraiser was waiting for information regarding the construction such as bid documents, spec book, plans and survey before they could do the appraisal. Since all the information is now available we can now go forward. Typically a commercial appraisal of this magnitude takes 4-6 weeks.

We have also ordered the title insurance and research of the history of the property is underway. The report will be delivered to the bank in the next couple weeks.

The loan will not close until the appraisal has been reviewed and received by the bank so we are actually looking at closing on the loan in July.

New Spring Valley Road Driveway: The plans call for a new driveway off of Spring Valley road, east of the current Spring Valley entrance. The new entrance would be in line with the Liesener Soil driveway. Our new driveway is currently being blocked by a power pole, WE Energies is aware that the pole needs to be moved.
