Project Bid Notes

The Project bids are out for Excavating, Concrete Precast, Masonry, Steel, Architectural wood, Waterproofing, Roofing, Doors, Framing, Drywall, Flooring, Ceilings, Wall covering, Elevator, Plumbing, HVAC and Electrical went out for bid to over 112 area businesses. So far savings versus the proposed budget are being found. We're hopeful that during the entire bid process we will continue to see savings versus the budget. So far we have received three bids that have been accepted on some of the early construction items that will be used early on in the construction process. 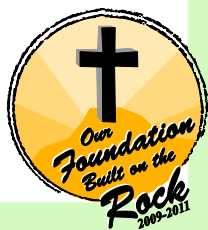
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A Look Ahead

A Two Week Look Ahead

- We are receiving bids for work over the next two weeks
- We have mobilized trailers and some equipment on Friday May 29th (we will not impact any areas with students or staff).
- On Monday June 1st, we will establish the construction boundaries and close the West side and the South side entrances to the school (the one further West on the South side). The entrance to the Gym will remain open for the time being.
- The turn-around drive and associated parking West of the school will be off limits starting Monday June 1st
- The parking South of the school, by the church office, will be limited starting Monday June 1st. Access to the church office will be maintained.
- Construction activity will be Monday thru Friday 6:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.
- Construction signage will be posted at all building entrances affected by construction.

Septic System

The current Septic system will need to be replaced as we complete the current building project or prior to any future building. The current system has served us well over many years and we've modified our use of the system for the school, hot lunch program and have worked to keep the system in the best shape we can. It is however, 40+ years old and is out of code. We will continue our discussion with the government about our system and explore every possibility prior to making any decisions about a future septic system.

Remove, Recycle, Reuse and Rebuild

With the new building comes, landscaping and we're in early talks with a health clinic in Jackson to remove a retaining wall, recycle it, reuse and rebuild it on the David's Star property for the building project. This is just one of many ways we're looking to continue to keep the building project under budget and recycle at the same time.
