PRESS RELEASE:

Washington Co., WI – The Washington County Fire Chiefs Association will be hosting its annual **Fire Prevention Week** kickoff event at the **Washington County Fair Park on Friday, October 2, 2020, from 6 p.m. until 8 p.m.**

The drive through event will feature apparatus from Washington County fire departments, as well as fire prevention materials. The materials will be distributed to visitors in their vehicles as they drive through to see the apparatus and personnel.

The theme for this year is: "Serve Up Fire Safety in the Kitchen."

According to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), based on 2013 through 2017 annual averages:

- Cooking equipment is the leading cause of home fires and fire injuries, causing 49% of home fires that resulted in 21% of the home fire deaths and 45% of the injuries.
- Unattended equipment is a factor in one-third (31%) of reported home cooking fires and half (48%) of the associated deaths. Two-thirds (66%) of home cooking fires start with the ignition of food or other cooking materials.
- Ranges or cooktops account for almost two-thirds (62%) of home cooking fire incidents.
- Frying dominates the cooking fire problem.
- Thanksgiving is the peak day for home cooking fires, followed by Christmas Day and Christmas Eve.

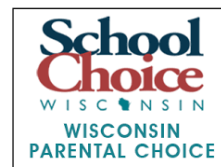

Cooking safety tips:

- Be on alert! If you are sleepy or have consumed alcohol, don't use the stove or stovetop.
- Stay in the kitchen while you are frying, grilling, boiling, or broiling food.
- If you are simmering, baking, or roasting food, check it regularly, remain in the kitchen while food is cooking, and use a timer to remind you that you are cooking.
- Keep anything that can catch fire — oven mitts, wooden utensils, food packaging, towels or curtains — away from your stovetop.

Even though Fire Prevention Week is only one week per year, fire prevention should be in our minds 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, all year round.

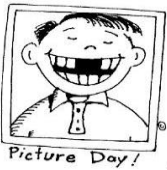

The mission of Martin Luther College is to train a corps of Christian witnesses who are qualified to meet the ministry needs of the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS) and who are competent to proclaim the Word of God faithfully and in accord with the Lutheran Confessions in the Book of Concord. MLC also offers professional growth opportunities and synod certification for called workers who are already serving in the ministry. The Congregational Partner Grant Program (CPGP) was a pilot project for the 2016-2017 academic year in which a congregation that submitted grant aid to support incoming freshmen with up to \$1000 per student would have their funding matched by MLC. During the second year of the program, it was expanded to include sophomore students as well. The third year of the program added junior students as eligible recipients and after four years has grown to include all enrolled students at MLC!

The continuation of this program in future years relies heavily on donors and the success of MLC's [Equipping Christian Witnesses Campaign](#). Your contribution can help MLC match the grants given to students whose congregations participate in the program for years to come.

God instructs us to share his Word with all people and one way Martin Luther College does this is by preparing men and women to be pastors and teachers. The students are led to study the Holy Scripture and encouraged to daily stay in the Word of God so they may grow their personal faith throughout their lives. The students are also trained and equipped with skills necessary for sharing God's Word with all people.
