

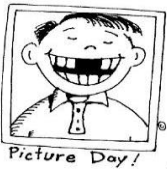


## BAND LESSONS BEGIN

## IMMUNIZATIONS – UP TO DATE

Please make sure your child/ren vaccinations are up to date before October 7, 2020. If you have an appointment scheduled please call the school office to notify us of your child's appointment date.

**Student Immunization Record (or simply called "record"):** This includes the vaccine date and number of doses the student has received.

**Vaccination waiver:** There are two types of waivers. The first is a **medical waiver** used when a student cannot get a vaccine due to a medical issue.

The second type is due to an objection to one or more vaccinations by a parent or adult student based on a **personal or religious objection** (under Wis. Stat. § 252.04). A signed, written waiver must be provided to the school and updated when new vaccines are due. Note: Proof of previously administered vaccinations must be provided to the school.

The mission of Martin Luther College is to train a corps of Christian witnesses who are qualified to meet the ministry needs of the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS) and who are competent to proclaim the Word of God faithfully and in accord with the Lutheran Confessions in the Book of Concord. MLC also offers professional growth opportunities and synod certification for called workers who are already serving in the ministry. The Congregational Partner Grant Program (CPGP) was a pilot project for the 2016-2017 academic year in which a congregation that submitted grant aid to support incoming freshmen with up to \$1000 per student would have their funding matched by MLC. During the second year of the program, it was expanded to include sophomore students as well. The third year of the program added junior students as eligible recipients and after four years has grown to include all enrolled students at MLC!

**The continuation of this program** in future years relies heavily on donors and the success of MLC's [Equipping Christian Witnesses Campaign](#). Your contribution can help MLC match the grants given to students whose congregations participate in the program for years to come.

God instructs us to share his Word with all people and one way Martin Luther College does this is by preparing men and women to be pastors and teachers. The students are led to study the Holy Scripture and encouraged to daily stay in the Word of God so they may grow their personal faith throughout their lives.
