Pastor Keith Free (WELS Board for Home Missions) has agreed to preach for our Mission Festival in August. Please note that Mission Festival will be held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday in August this year. Koine, a WELS church band, has agreed to play for our outdoor service. Effective this year, a joint decision was made between David's Star and Morning Star to discontinue the "joint" Mission Festival Service. We continue to have visitors at worship every weekend. Some are from other WELS churches. Some are not. Please continue to welcome all our visitors as they join you in the pew for worship. Brian reported that the internet tower is fully functional, and it was switched over to the school last week.

Rob reported that items remaining to do on the tower include landscaping rocks and a fence. This will be done in spring.

Meyers Roofing was contacted to complete the work on our steeple. The estimate is \$1200.00 higher than our previous proposal from several years ago.

We are presently looking at our dishwasher in the kitchen as it is not getting hot enough to meet standards for the hot lunch program.

A bubbler upstairs is broken, and we are looking at replacing it.

Rob informed Council that our present insurance policy does not cover our students for medical coverage. We would need to add a rider which would cost \$1050.00 extra per year to add students, and another \$430 to specifically cover student athletes. The School Board will look into whether this additional coverage should be obtained, and if it would be appropriate to cover through student fees.

Bob reported that the Board is looking into restructuring "early childhood education" at the school offering several options for parents for the 4K and 5K programs. The standard classroom teaching times would remain the same, but programs would be expanded to include child care during non-classroom times.

The 4K program options would include:

1. Standard 4K program – Three days a week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday) from 8:30-11:30 Annual Cost \$1,450.00
2. 4K ½ Day program – Five days a week from 8:30-11:30 Proposed Fee \$1,995
3. 4K Full Day program – Proposed fee \$3,995

The 5K program options would include:

1. 5K Standard program – Monday-Friday from 8:30 -11:30; Annual cost \$1,010.00
2. 5K Full Day program – Monday-Friday full days Proposed fee \$2,995

Bob also reported that the preschool and kindergarten nonmember tuition rates approved at the January voters meeting were incorrect. Although the \$100.00 increase that was approved was correct, the specific rates that were used were incorrect. Preschool rates should have been increased from \$2,415 to \$2,515 instead of \$2,065. Kindergarten rates should have been increased from \$3,750 to \$3,850 instead of \$3,300. Council agreed to have the rates corrected for the upcoming registration, and have the rates approved at the April voters meeting.

## TWO LITTLE STORIES

For many people stewardship is a difficult subject or a touchy topic or one that is easily ignored. Give thought to these two little stories.

- 1) When you go to a doctor for your annual check-up, he or she will often begin to poke, prod, and press various places, all the while asking, "Does this hurt? How about this?" If you cry out in pain, one of two things has happened. Either the doctor has pushed too hard, without the right sensitivity. Or, more likely, there's something wrong, and the doctor will say, "We'd better do some more tests. It's not supposed to hurt there!" So it is when pastors preach on biblical stewardship, and certain members cry out in discomfort, criticizing the message and the messenger. Either the pastor has pushed too hard. Or perhaps there's something wrong. In that case, I say, "My friend, we're in need of the Great Physician because it's not supposed to hurt there."
- 2) The story is told of a farmer who was known for his generous giving and whose friends could not understand how he could give so much and yet remain so prosperous. One day a spokesman for his friends said, "We can't understand you. You give far more than any of the rest of us and yet you always seem to have more to give." "Oh that is easy to explain," the farmer said. "I keep shoveling into God's bin and God keeps shoveling back into mine and God has the bigger shovel."
