After this year, the School Choice Program will only be available to students entering Kindergarten or 1st grade. As part of the application process, students new to the Choice Program must provide proof of income and residency documentation. Continuing Choice students only need to provide residency documentation.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** All required supporting documentation **must** be received by David's Star school office during the enrollment period.

Camp Phillip provides relaxation in creation and renewal in Christ. Located near Wautoma, Wisconsin, Camp Phillip has been hosting campers since 1968.

Each day, campers can be found all around Camp playing games, swimming, shooting archery, throwing tomahawks, and climbing the ropes course. Every evening after dinner, campers shout praises loudly during song period at the outdoor stage. Each night, you will find socially distant cabins gathered around a campfire watching skits and singing songs. Most importantly, many times throughout the day, you will see campers reading, listening to, and diving into God's Word!

Camps are offered for half and whole weeks. Sunshine offers great activities like archery, crafts, and tomahawks, and older campers will enjoy the high ropes course. There are specialty camps to focus more on archery, art, horseback, rocketry, and rock climbing, among others. Fledging camp is a half week for 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade campers. Peewee Camp is a half week camp for Kindergarten-2<sup>nd</sup> grade campers who stay with their families at night and join the camp staff for outrageously fun activities during the day.

## **DS TUITION ASSISTANCE**

Tuition assistance will be made available to both David's Star members and non-members pursuing membership status through active instruction with the pastors.

**Assistance is generally available for students in Kindergarten through 8th grade, though exceptions may be made for preschool on a case-by-case basis.**

The purpose of the Tuition Assistance Fund is to assist church members of David's Star Lutheran Church fund their children's Christian education. If you feel like you need tuition assistance, this application must be completed and returned to the school office May 1. Eligibility will be based on a formula that takes into consideration your level of income and other factors. The Principal, in conjunction with the Board of Elementary Education, will determine the amount available for distribution on an annual basis and that amount will be distributed evenly among all eligible students. Families will still be responsible for the balance associated with sending a child to David's Star.

**JAM** (Jesus and Me) is a Christ-centered program aimed at serving families with children who are not yet old enough for Kindergarten.

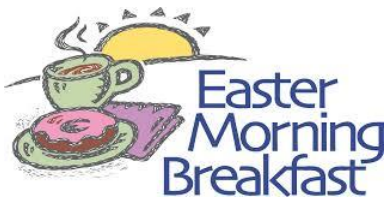
Children can be accompanied by a parent, grandparent, babysitter, etc. Activities include: Bible lessons, singing, free play, craft, and snack time.
