

## THIRD QUARTER MISSION PROJECT

### CENTRAL AFRICA MEDICAL MISSION

#### STUDENT COLLECTIONS \$438.52

*Mission envelopes are sent home weekly with each student and are collected on Wednesday Mornings.*

With God's help, hundreds of thousands of patients in Zambia and Malawi have been touched by the work of the Central Africa Medical Mission (CAMM). Mrs. Linda Liesener, a David's Star member, and Alicia Liesener, a former David's Star member, have been active in this mission effort of our Synod.

**Lutheran Mission Rural Health Centre – Zambia** Our clinic, originally known as the Mwembezi Clinic, was established in 1961 and is located about 50 miles northwest of Lusaka, the capitol of Zambia. The property consists of clinic buildings, Martin Luther Church, and housing for workers. Medical services include preventive health care for children and expectant women, as well as treatment of patients with illnesses. Extended services are also provided. Our clinic continues to be recognized by the Zambian government for exemplary care.

- **Lutheran Mobile Clinic – Malawi**-The Lutheran Mobile Clinic was established in 1970 and operates from Lilongwe, the capitol of Malawi. A Land Cruiser serves as the clinic ambulance and transports the medical staff and supplies to four different clinic sites ranging from a 20 minute to 1-hour ride from Lilongwe. Sites include Suzi, Mwalaulomwe, Thunga, and Msambo. Each clinic site has a one-room building, which conducts clinic one day a week, and serves as a church site on Sundays and for other gatherings during the week. The clinic focuses on preventive health care, but also tends to those that need medical attention. An infant wellness program that includes immunizations is provided for children birth to age 5. Prenatal care is provided to expectant women; all sick patients receive examinations and treatment from a trained clinician. Nutrition classes and health lessons are also provided to those attending.

The Lutheran Mobile Clinic national staff is under the direction of an American Nurse-in-charge and Clinic Health Administrator who each serve a 3-year term.

Together, the clinics in Zambia and Malawi serve over 80,000 patients a year. Each clinic day begins with devotion so that all in attendance can hear the Good News of their Savior.

## DS TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition assistance will be made available to both David's Star members and non-members pursuing membership status through active instruction with the pastors.

**Assistance is generally available for students in Kindergarten through 8th grade, though exceptions may be made for preschool on a case-by-case basis.**

The purpose of the Tuition Assistance Fund is to assist church members of David's Star Lutheran Church fund their children's Christian education. If you feel like you need tuition assistance, this application must be completed and returned to the school office May 1. Eligibility will be based on a formula that takes into consideration your level of income and other factors. The Principal, in conjunction with the Board of Elementary Education, will determine the amount available for distribution on an annual basis and that amount will be distributed evenly among all eligible students. Families will still be responsible for the balance associated with sending a child to David's Star.
